# Vaccination campaign

Le Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides wishes to remind its population that the respiratory virus vaccination campaign is underway in the Laurentians.



The campaign is designed to offer, **free of charge**, the flu vaccine and the COVID-19 vaccine to the entire population and the pneumococcal vaccine to certain groups of people. <u>Vaccination is highly recommended to people who are at</u> higher risk for complications as well as healthcare workers.

People considered vulnerable or high risk are:

- People living in residential and long-term care centers (CHSLDs), in private residences for seniors or living in other collective environments having a high ratio of seniors and/or vulnerable people ;
- People aged 60 years or older ;
- People who are immunocompromised, who on dialysis, or living with a chronic conditions;
- Pregnant women and parents of babies of less than 6 months of age ;
- Healthcare workers ;
- Adults living in remote or isolated areas.

Vulnerable people are invited to book an appointment. It will be possible to receive the flu and COVID-19 vaccine during the same appointment. The pneumococcal vaccine may also be offered to eligible people.

To facilitate the access to services to the population of the Laurentians, vaccination will be offered in all local services points (vaccination) as well as certain pharmacies. Appointments will **not** be given by the local service points.
