BURNING PERMIT

For all burning needs, we remind you that it is necessary to obtain a burning permit. We invite you to consult By-law 2024-03 concerning burning, available on the Municipality of Lac-des-Seize-Îles website.

Permits are free of charge.

You can request one directly from our office or online by completing the form provided on our website, then e-mailing it to us at info@lac-des-seize-iles.com. We recommend that you make your request at least 2 days before the day of the burn.

PARKING STICKERS




Parking sticker renewal - Season 2025

The measures put in place by the municipality in response to public demand for safety, improvements and accessibility to the north and south parking lots have borne fruit. Thanks to the introduction of the vignette system, parking access is now managed more efficiently.



Now is the time to **renew your parking sticker for the 2025 season**.

To do so, you need to affix a **2025 sticker** to your current sticker. These stickers are available from the municipal office, at a cost of **\$25 per sticker**.

 In the event of **loss, theft, damage or replacement** of a sticker, a new written request is required and a **\$10** fee applies.

New shoreline property owners: are you eligible?

To obtain a parking sticker (north or south), you must:

-  Be a resident of a property built without an access road
-  A **maximum of two stickers** is issued per eligible property.


The following documents are required:


1. **Application form** (available on our website or at the municipal office)
2. **Payment of \$25** per sticker (cash, cheque or Interac transfer)

No sticker will be issued until all documents and payment have been received.


Reminder of the obligations of vignette holders

- The sticker must be **hung from the vehicle's rearview mirror**, clearly visible from the outside.
- It must **be returned to the municipality** when unused or not required.

 Stickers are **mandatory from June 15 to September 15** and must be renewed every year.

Update 2025 - Sticker system for watercrafts

Lakes are at the heart of our municipality's identity and pride. Their protection remains a priority for the municipal council, and a number of measures have been put in place over the years to ensure their preservation.

An experimental **vignette system for watercraft** was introduced in **2023**. In **2024**, we repeated the experiment, making a few adjustments. These two years enabled us to gain a better understanding of the challenges involved in identifying and managing watercraft.

In 2025, we are relaunching the process in a structured and sustainable way, with several important improvements. In particular, stickers will now be **numbered and associated with each motorized craft**, enabling better tracking. It will no longer be necessary to affix stickers to non-motorized craft.

Two types of vignettes will be issued this year:

They will no longer be required for non-motorized boats.

- - Green vignettes: for residents;
- - Yellow stickers: for seasonal non-residents.

These stickers are **compulsory and free of charge**. Those issued in 2024 are no longer valid.

A **new form** is now available on our website or in hard copy at the municipal office. It can also be sent by e-mail on request to info@lac-des-seize-iles.com. Once completed, please return it by e-mail to the same address. We'll prepare your stickers in advance, in your name, so you don't have to wait for collection.

You can pick up your stickers at the municipal office, at your convenience.

Please note that no stickers will be sent by mail.

*Since the introduction of the parking sticker, the period of grace has come to an end. As of this date, failure to register or renew your parking sticker will result in a fine as stipulated in By-law 2023-03. We encourage you to take the necessary steps to avoid any inconvenience.
